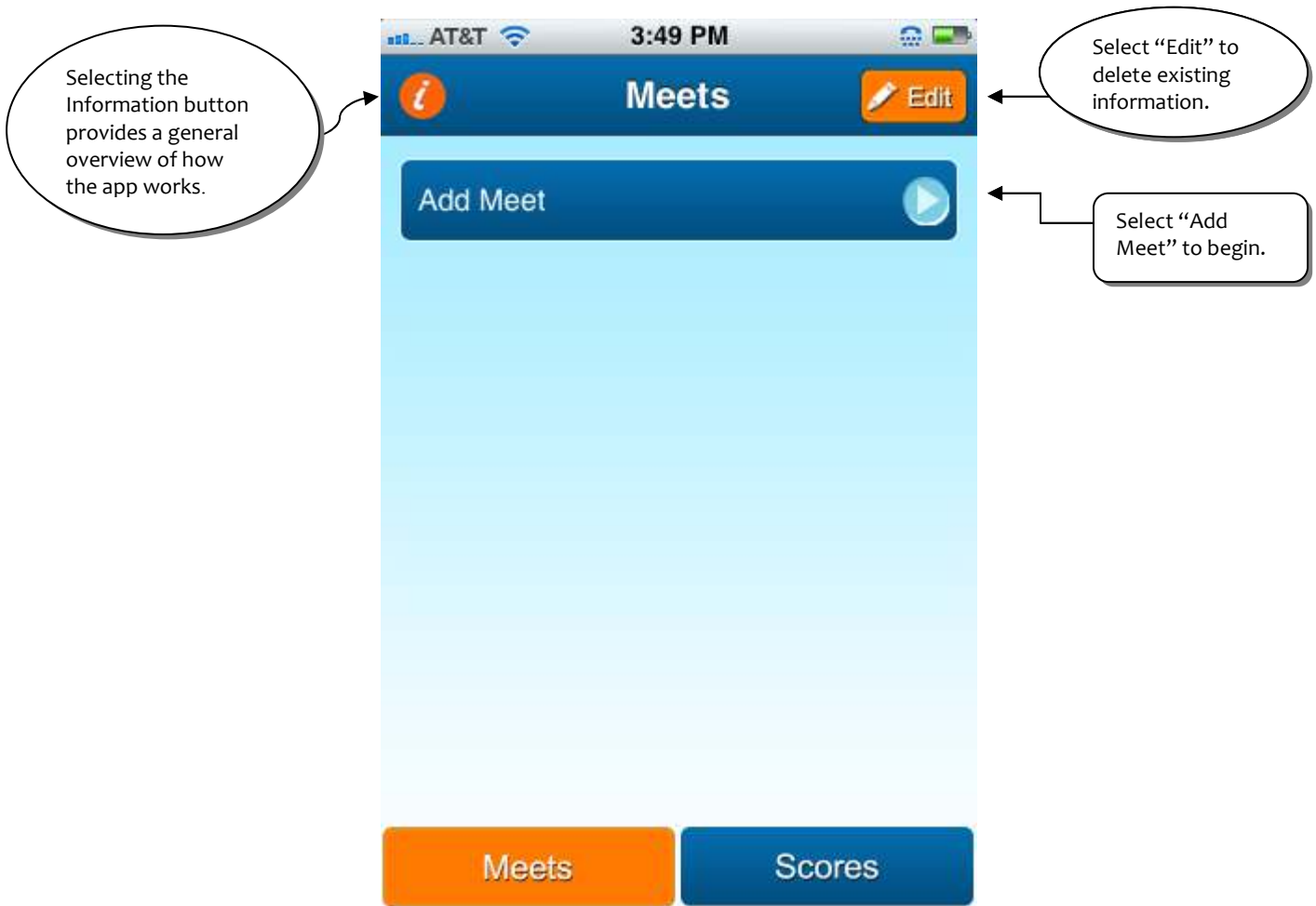

iDIVE SCORE USER GUIDE

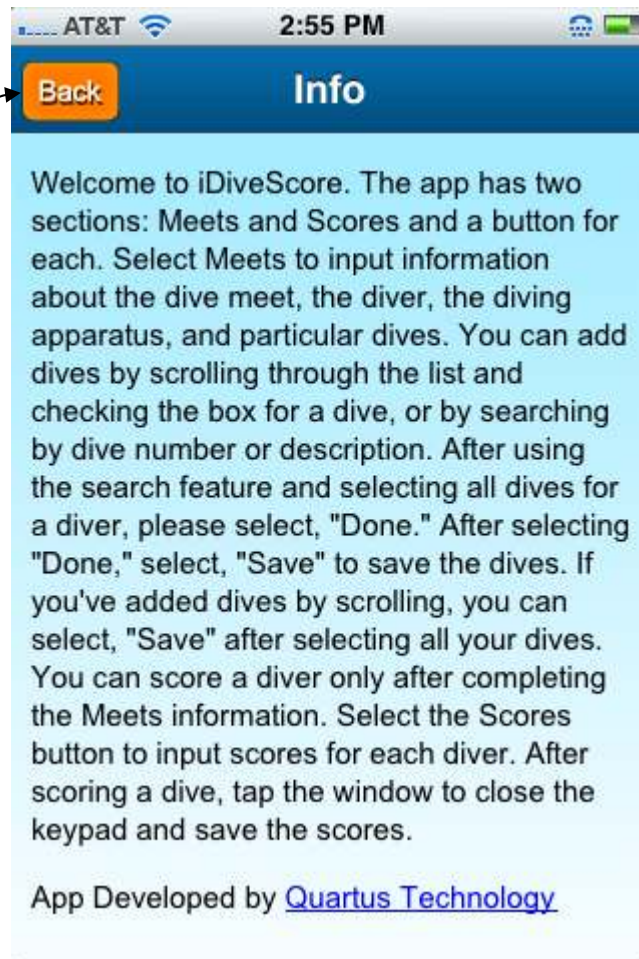
The screen shots below are in the order they appear to a user when using the app.



This is the first screen to appear when opening the app. There are two sections to the app as noted by the two buttons, "Meets" and "Scores" located on the bottom of the app screen. The Meets section is where all meet, event, dive height, dive apparatus, diver, and dive selection takes place. The app defaults to the Meets section when the app opens. The Scores section is where the user will enter the scores the diver receives when performing the dives.

If a user selects the “i” button shown on the previous screen, the user will be presented with this Information screen which provides a brief synopsis of how to use the app.

Select the “Back” button to go back to the “Add Meet” screen.

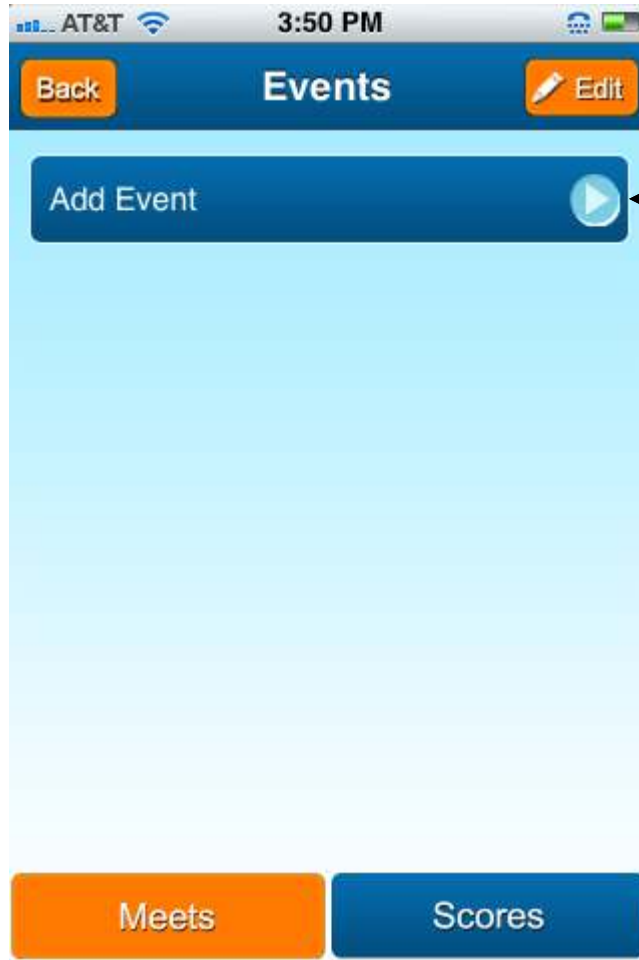

After inputting requested information, select "Save" to move to the next screen.

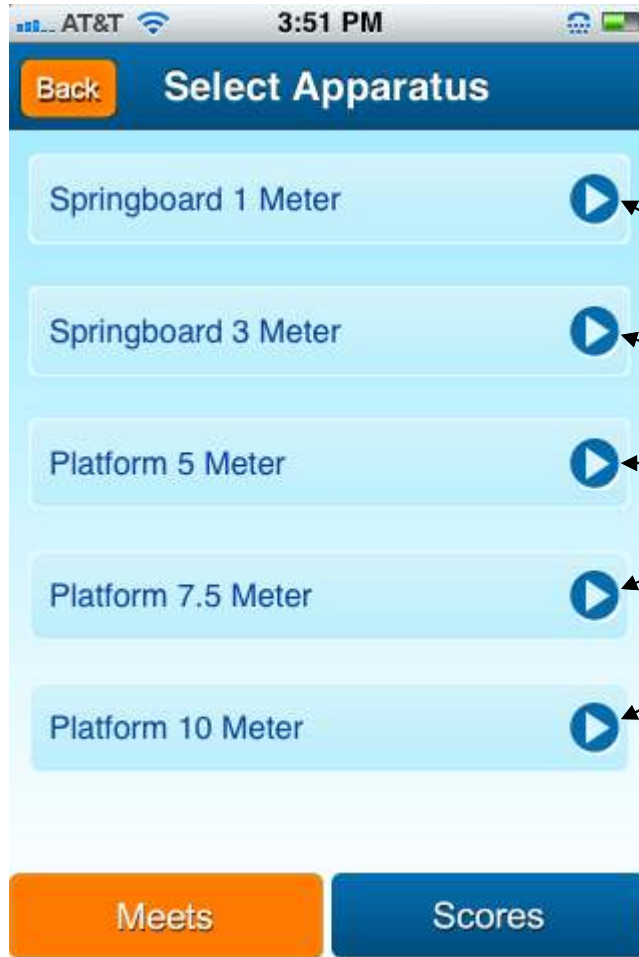


Select to move to the next screen to add an event.

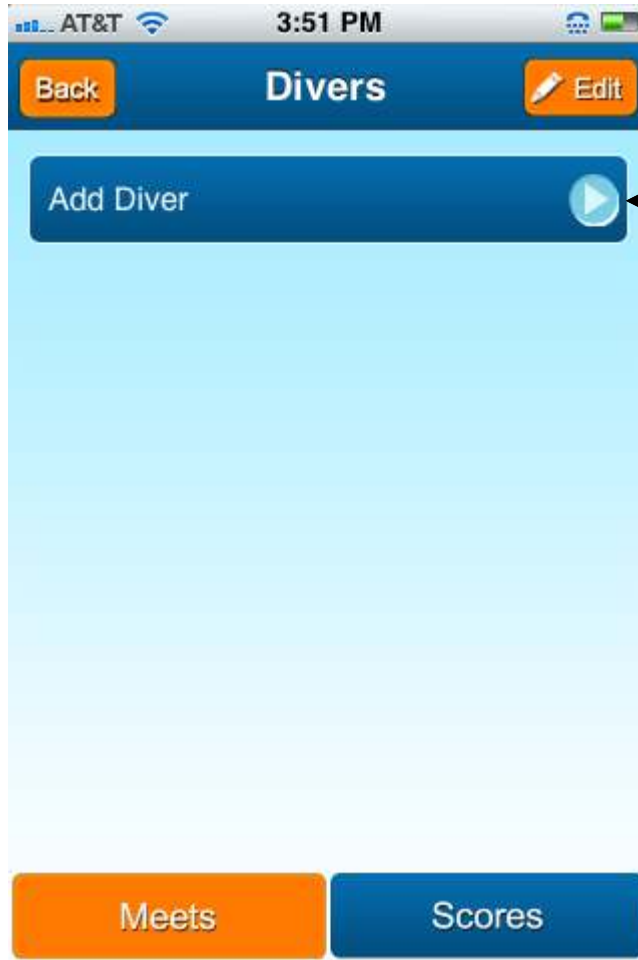


Select "Save" to save the information and move to the next screen.

Input the event name. The user can input any name to identify an event.



Select the applicable apparatus for the event. The app will provide the dives available for each apparatus automatically. Selecting an apparatus will bring you to the next page.



Select to add your diver.

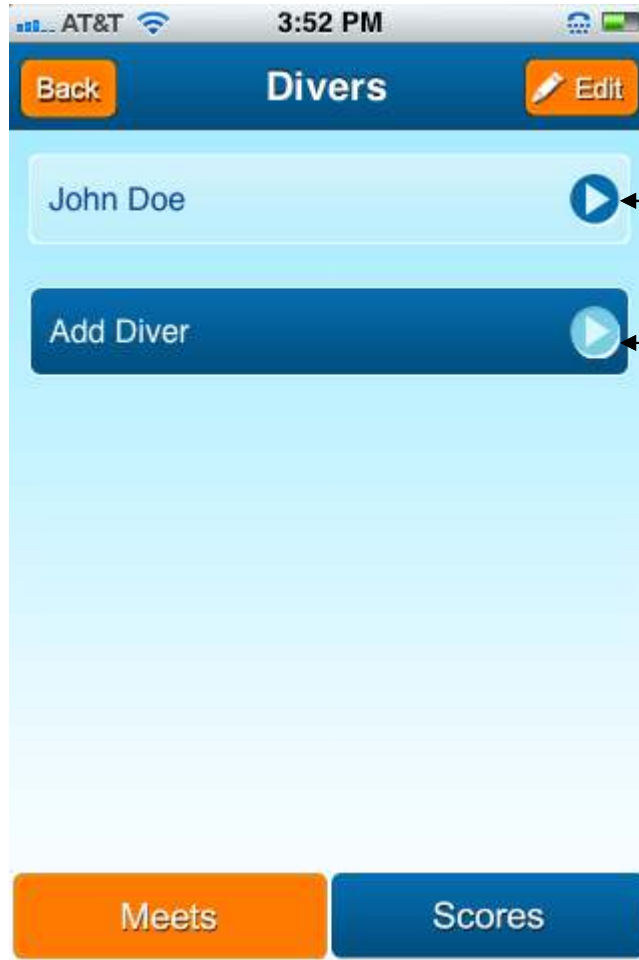

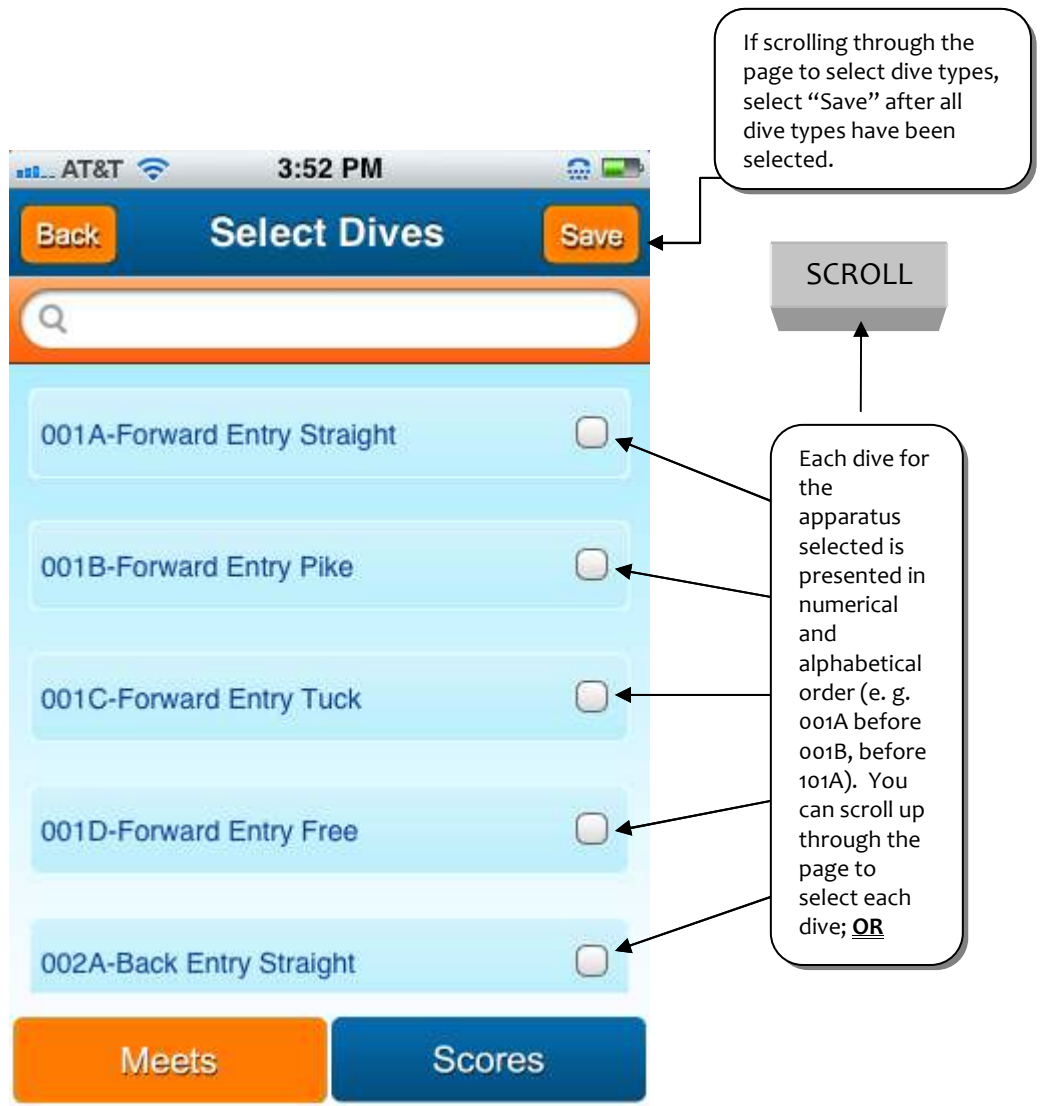
Meets Scores

Select "Save" to move back a screen to add another diver.

Input an email address where to send the diver's final results for the event selected. An email address is required to advance to the next screen. This can be a fictitious address if the diver does not intend to have the results sent by email.



Either add another diver, or select a diver to begin adding dive types.





You can search for a dive in the search field by dive number; OR



You can search by dive description.

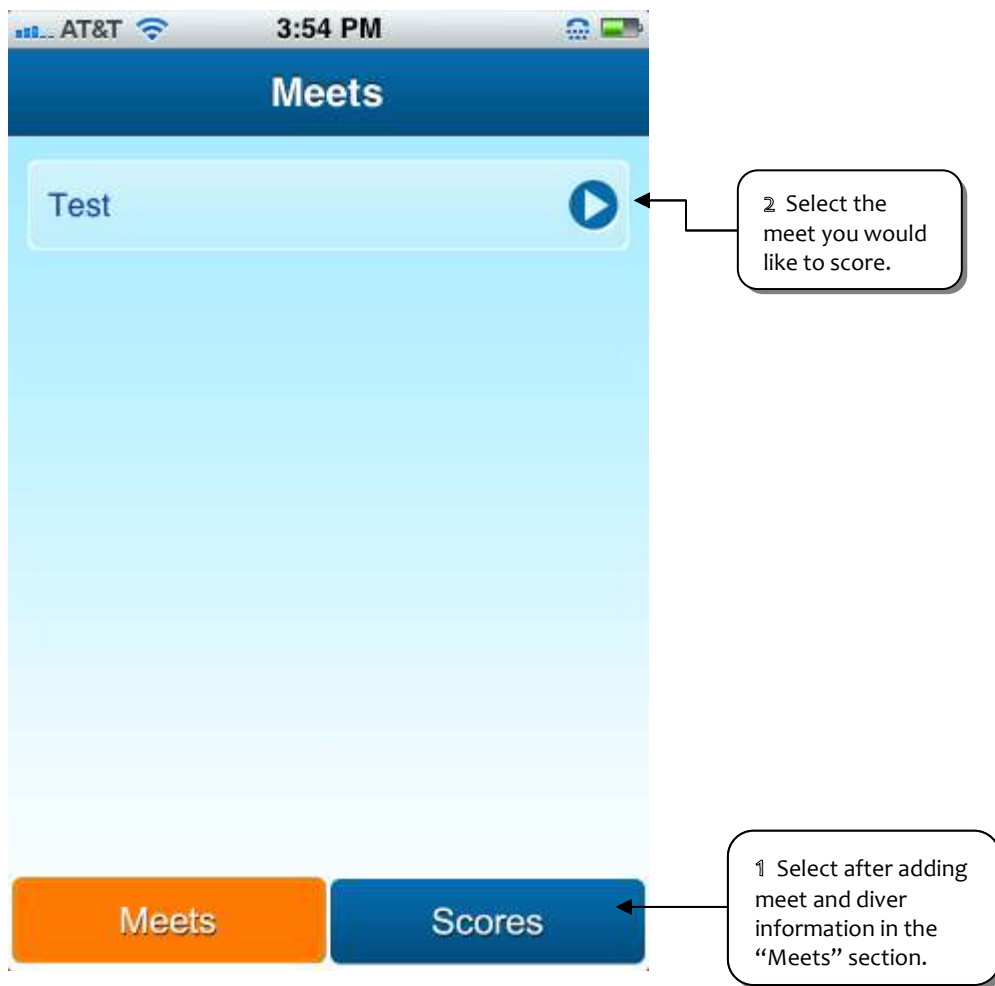
Clear the search field each time before searching for a new dive.

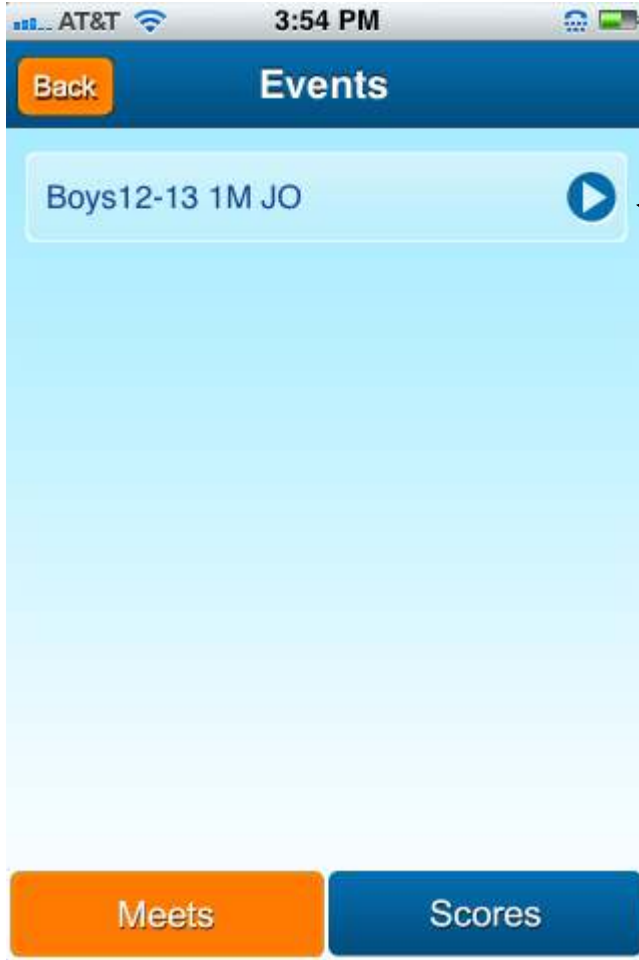
“Save” button becomes active after selecting “Done”. Select “Save” once all desired dives have been selected.

Select “Done” after all desired dives have been selected.

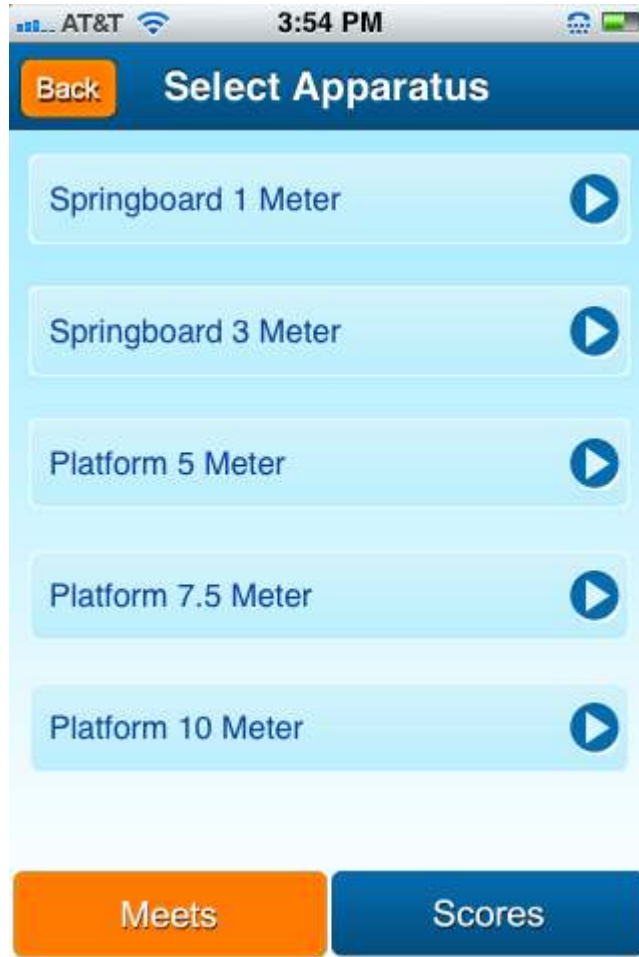
Tap the box to select the dive you want. Continue the process until all desired dives are selected.

After information has been added for all divers in an event, the event is ready to be scored. This is the initial Scores page that appears once the user selects the “Scores” button. The Scores section enables the user to score a diver for any event where there is diver information. Each meet a user enters will appear in this section, including completed meets. A completed meet will remain in this section until deleted by the user.

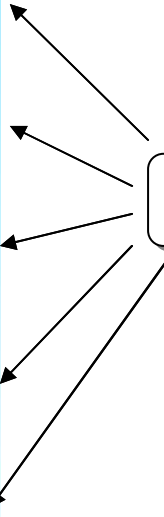




Select the event you would like to score.



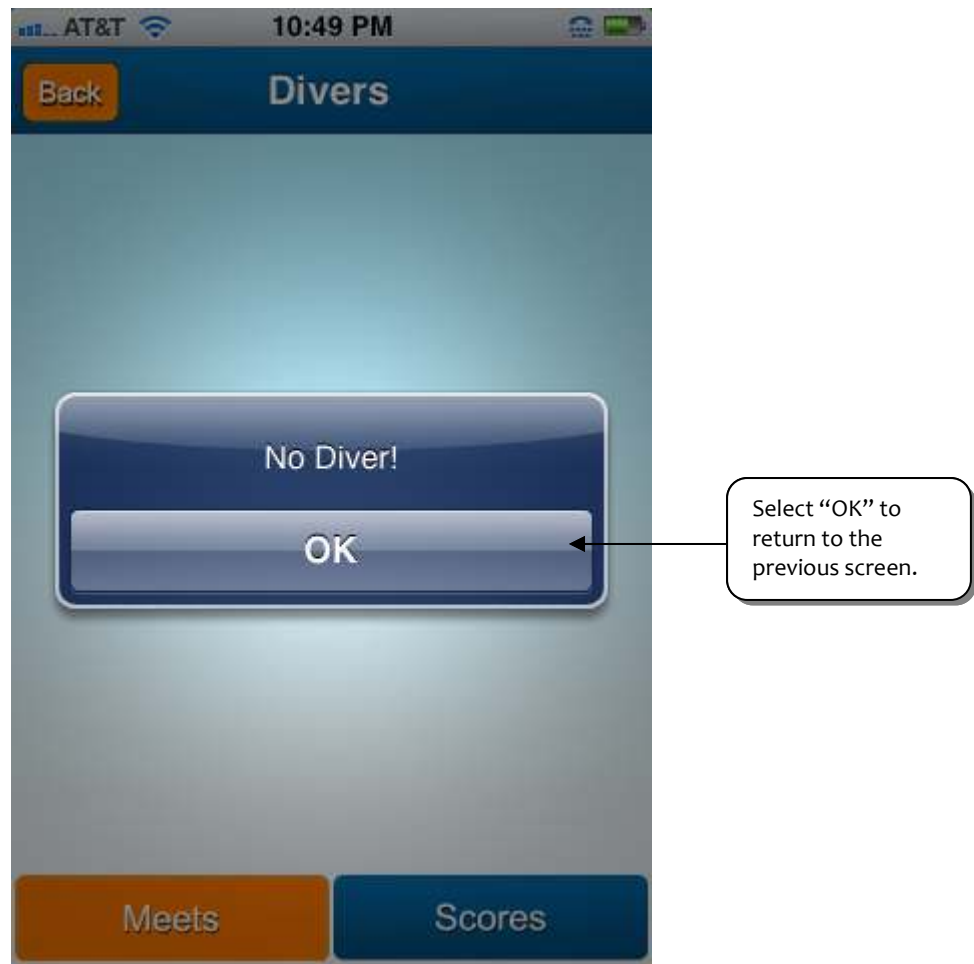
Select that event's diving apparatus.

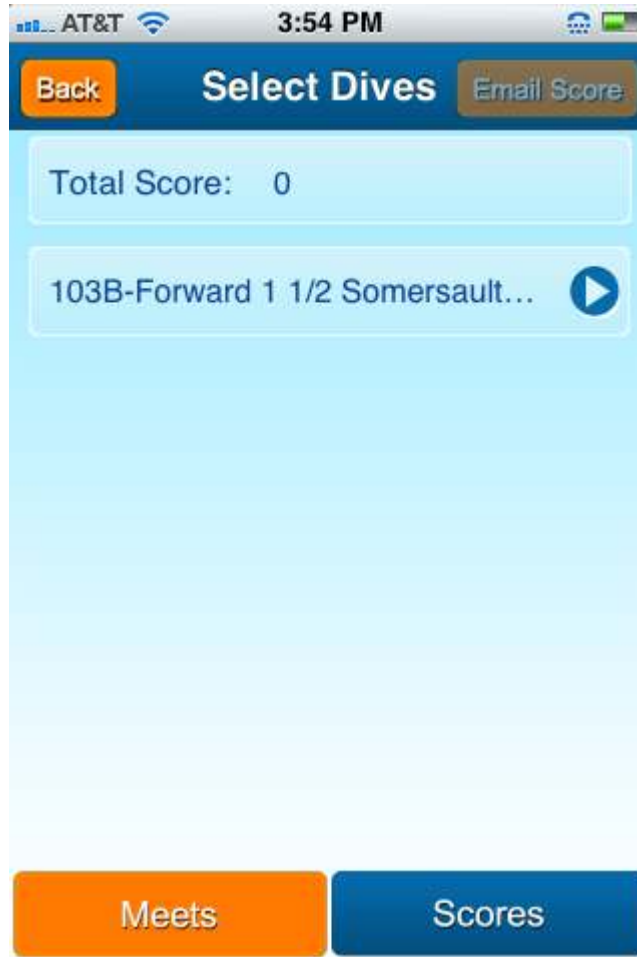




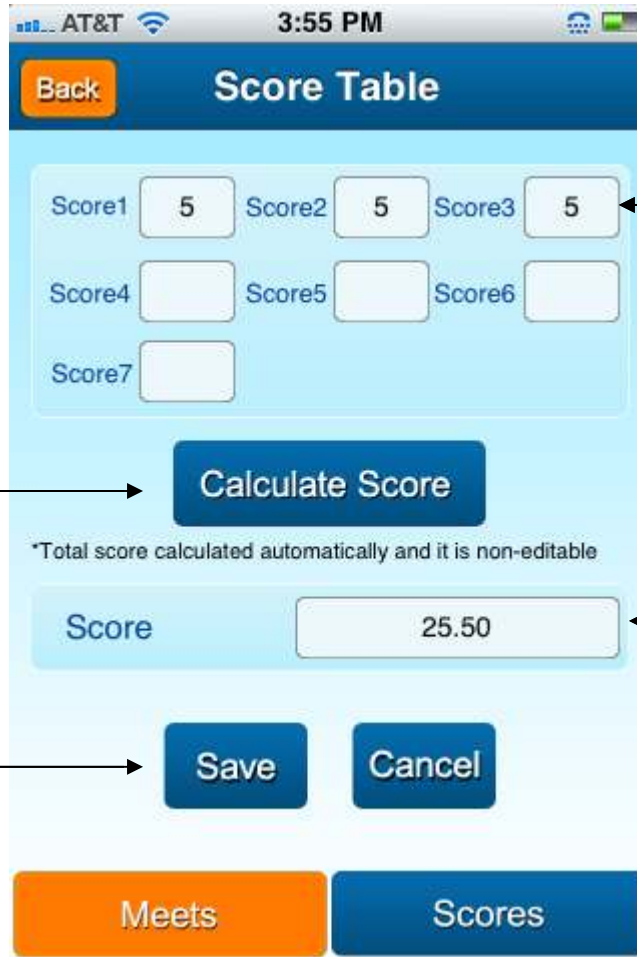
Select the diver to score.

This screen will appear if there is no diver information for the dive apparatus selected. This means that the diver and selected dives must be inputted in the Meets section before the diver can be scored.





Select the dive to score. All dives entered will appear in this section and dives will appear in numerical order despite the order the dives were entered. Some awareness on the user's part is needed here as the dives will likely not be in the order the diver performs them.



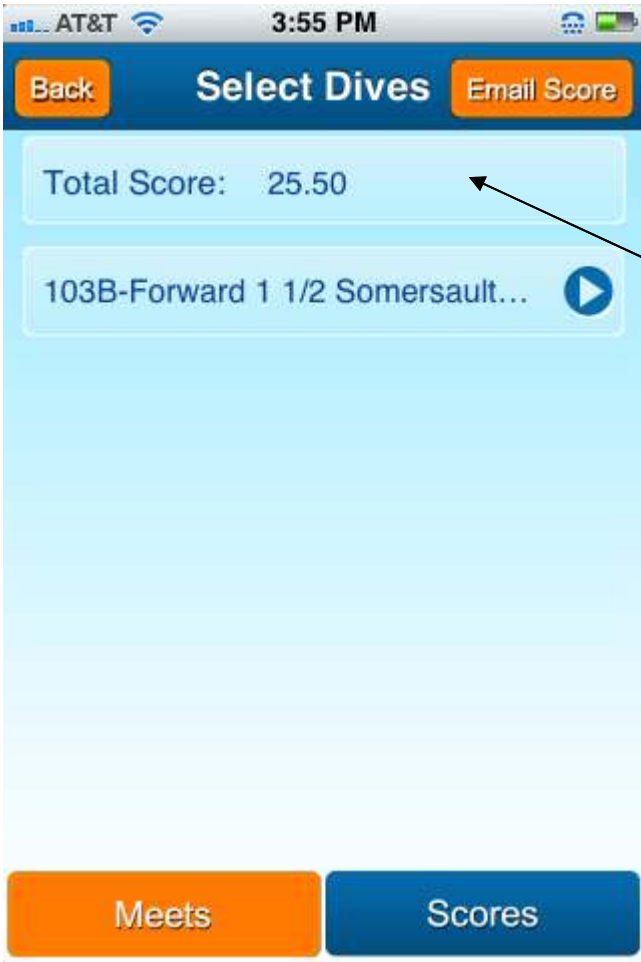
Input as many scores as there are judges. Tapping each score box will enable you to input the scores.

After entering all scores, tap the screen to remove the keyboard and press here to calculate the score

The app will take the raw score and multiply it by the dive's degree of difficulty to arrive at the total score.

Select "Save" to save the score and move back to the prior screen

Select "Back" to move back a page to select the next diver.



After scoring all dives for a diver, you can send an email of the scores to the email address previously inputted for that diver.

The app will keep a running total of the diver's score which will be shown here after each dive is scored.
